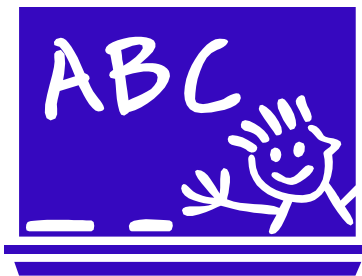


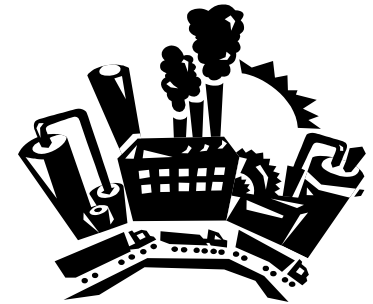
What Is SECAC?

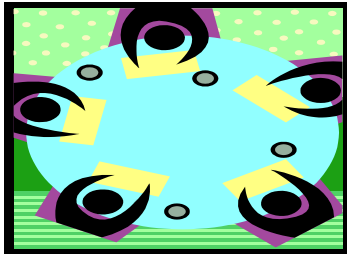
